8 West to 5 North to Cannon Road East
Follow signs to LEGOLAND

From Los Angeles and Orange County:

405 South/5 South to Cannon Road East

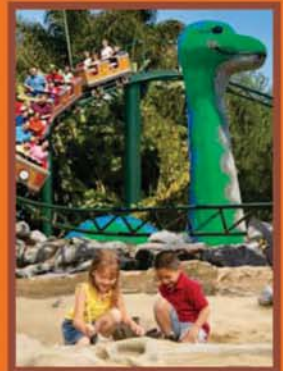
FUN TOWN

A Guests who cannot physically help themselves into the ride must ride with an assistant capable of helping them off the ride in case of an emergency.

B This ride not suitable for sight-impaired guests.

C Driver must be able to use the pedal and steer.

D Guests must be able to sit in an upright position without assistance.

E Ride not recommended for those with high blood pressure, heart, neck, back problems, or other physical limitations.

F Expectant mothers are not recommended to ride.

G All riders must be a minimum of 40" to ride. Riders between 40" and 48" must wear a safety vest, may only ride level 1 and must be accompanied by a rider 55" or taller. Riders 48" to 55" must ride on a level 1 or 2, and must be accompanied by a rider 55" or taller. Riders over 55" may ride alone and may ride levels 1-5. Guest 77" or taller may not ride. Guests must be able to fit seat and be properly secured by restraint.

H Weight limit of 175 lbs. per horse. Guests must be able to fit seat restraint, sit upright and have lower body control to straddle the seat without any assistance. Guests must be able to hold onto the ride vehicle at all times.

I Riders may get wet or possibly soaked.

J Service animals are allowed and must sit on the floor of the vehicle next to their owner. No other animals are allowed.

K Child riders must be of walking age.
